### Release of the Implicit Measure of Distinct Emotional States

This includes further distributing, copying, or disseminating to a different facility or organizational unit within the requesting university, organization, or company.
2. Modification and Commercial Use: Licensee may not modify the IMDES or use it for commercial purposes without prior approval from Dr. Bartoszek. The license granted herein is specifically for the internal research purposes of Licensee.
3. Publication Requirements: Licensees is prohibited from publishing the IMDES images in reports, papers, or other documents.
